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Adaptive Food Systems Accelerator

- Research Centre

Our mission is to develop the concept of Adaptive Food Systems in response to the challenges posed by the European Commission's Food2030 policy and the 17 Sustainable Development Goals set by the United Nations.

In the field of food technology and nutrition, we are particularly interested in innovative processing techniques, producing high-quality food and responding to the challenges of feeding a growing global population. We are keenly interested in the rapidly developing local market for high-quality food production, which is part of the National Intelligent Specialisation and Lower Silesian Intelligent Specialisation.

What do we offer?

- partnership in innovative implementation-based projects (both national and international), involving the planning and execution of research and development work in areas such as:
 - the use of ancient cereals (e.g. spelt, emmer wheat or Einkorn wheat) and non-standard cereals (e.g. buckwheat, amaranth or glass gem corn) to develop innovative food product recipes
 - developing gluten-free and dairy-free product recipes using exclusively plant-based ingredients or incorporating edible insects
 - analysing and creating innovative health-promoting recipes using traditional plant raw materials, such as non-noble grape varieties, cornus, chokeberries and sloes, with a focus on maintaining high antioxidant activity
 - managing waste streams from the food industry (e.g. fruit and vegetable pomace or vegetable leaves) and developing food product formulations that effectively incorporate these raw materials.

- utilising modern techniques for isolating active substances from plant raw materials (microwave-assisted extraction, ultrasound-assisted extraction, supercritical carbon dioxide extraction, electromagnetic field-assisted solvent extraction)
- applying beta-glucan (1-3-ß-D-glucan, 1-3, 1-4-ß-D-glucan or 1-3, 1-6-ß-D-glucan) as an active ingredient in food technology, cosmetics and pharmaceuticals
- biorefining plant raw materials to obtain substances and intermediates for use in food technology, cosmetics and pharmaceuticals
- using materials derived from the processing of plant raw materials to formulate functional food products
- conducting research on new systems and technological and production solutions, including their implementation and the introduction of new products and services as a subcontractor in projects
- providing opinions, expert reports and analyses
- offering training, workshops and speakers in the area of adaptive food systems

- initiating networking activities for the international, national and regional collaboration between experts from academia and industry partners
- advising on the internationalisation of innovative solutions in food industry processing
- conducting market research, taking into account the needs, constraints and sociocultural characteristics in traditional, niche and innovative food production and consumption.
