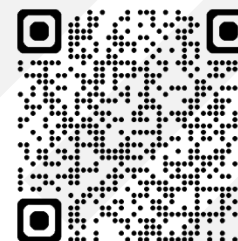

How does it work?

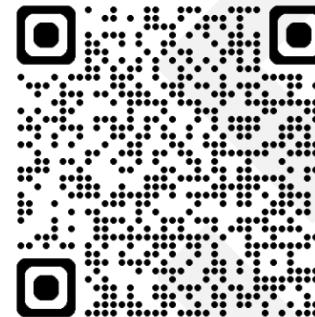

When can you apply?

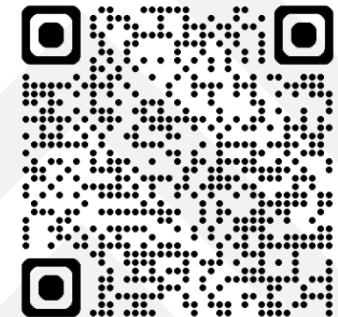
Mentor recruitment is open throughout the year. Information about available thesis topics is published in November, and this is also when you can expect to hear from us if your expertise matches a proposed topic.

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Guest Lectures

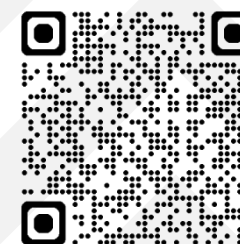
Do you have professional knowledge and experience that you would like to share with students?

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The Business Process Simulation Centre

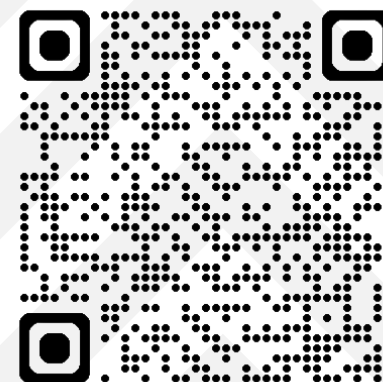
Functional areas

- Process Design Zone – business process modelling, 3D visualisation, and workshop-based collaboration (12 participant workstations and one trainer workstation).
- Virtual Reality Zone – interactive simulations and decision-making games in immersive virtual environments (6 VR workstations).

- Manufacturing, logistics, administrative, and commercial processes.
- Financial and managerial decision-making, including:
 - ✓ liquidity management,
 - ✓ investment appraisal,
 - ✓ resource consumption analysis,
 - ✓ production and service cost accounting.

Accounting and Financial Management

Business Accounting (online, in cooperation with CIMA)

A practice-oriented programme covering financial accounting, management accounting, and corporate reporting, preparing participants for careers in the finance and accounting departments of international organisations.

International Human Resources Management

A programme focused on managing people in an international environment, covering topics such as recruitment, employee development, intercultural communication, and building high-performing teams. 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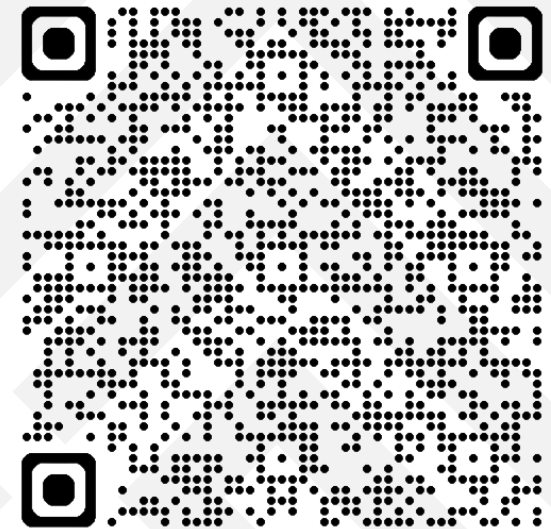

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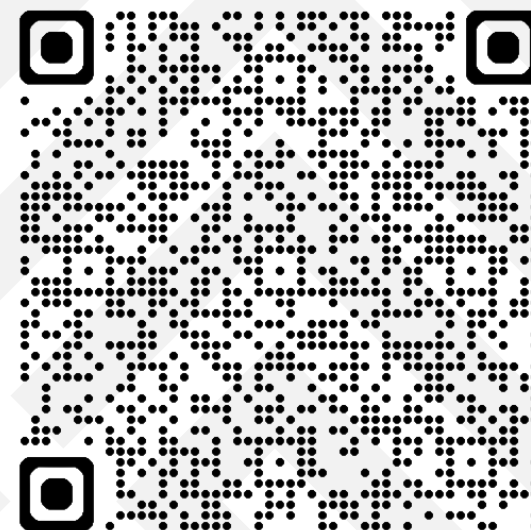
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
